SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

Scholarship Subcommittee

The Scholarship Subcommittee operates under the Education and Candidate Guidance Committee. The Scholarship Subcommittee is responsible for:

- a. understand the scholarship offerings
- b. market the scholarship program
- c. answer questions and inquires regarding the scholarship program
- d. call for scholarship applications no later than
- e. review annual scholarship applications
- f. recommend scholarship awards to the Board by October 1st
- g. notify all applicants of decision no later than November 1st

The Board is responsible for approving the final awards. The Executive Director is responsible for submitting the information to the CCIM Institute by the required deadline.

Scholarship Applicant Qualifications

At the time of scholarship application, applicant must meet the following qualifications to be considered:

- be a current Chapter member

At the time of scholarship redemption, award recipient must meet the following requirements to receive funding:

- be a current Chapter member

Scholarship Offerings

- Foundation Scholarship through 2017
- Chapter Scholarships (Two awards at \$1000 to each applicant per year)
